The author will typically write an introduction to the nature of research on the Ruralia theme in their country, and focus on a particular example/s arising from their own research.

Each paper submitted by authors contains a title and two subtitles, translated into other languages used in Ruralia volumes (English, French, German). Each submitted paper includes a short and concise abstract translated in three above mentioned languages. Recommended length = 600 characters with spaces.

Papers should not exceed 10 printed pages. We strongly recommend a text of 30.000 - 35.000 characters with space (about 5000 words) and some additional substantial figures. The editors accept the text 1x in printed form and simultaneously in electronic version (MS Word). The editors ask authors not to format the text or to lay it out in a graphically complex fashion, insert illustrations, graphs, tables and the like.

Quotes from literature are to be arranged in the same way as they were in previous Ruralia volumes. Footnotes serve solely to complement – or explain the text, or to present direct quotations and the like, but not for a bibliography.

Figures: The standard form of the figures is black and white. The editors accept figures in electronic form of a distinction of 300-400 DPI (in tiff, eps, jpg formats). The basis for the production of figures is the printing mirror of a page with the dimensions  $177 \times 246$  mm.
