STANDING ORDERS

In the standing orders of the Ruralia Association the association has further rules, based on the Articles of Association, that govern the day-to-day operations of the association.

The **name** of the association is Ruralia. The **suffix** of the association is: European association of medieval and post-medieval rural archaeology

The conference will be held **biennially**.

The official postal **address** of the Ruralia association is: Rijksdienst voor het Cultureel Erfgoed, Smallepad 5, Amersfoort, The Netherlands. The Contact address is the affiliation of the President/chair of Ruralia.

All correspondence (digital and analog) goes through the President's/chair's address.

A **Management Board** (former Executive Board) represents the Ruralia Association to the public. The Management Board is chaired by: the President (chair, the Vice-President) Further members are a Secretary and a Vice-Secretary, a Treasurer and a Vice-Treasurer. The current members of the Management Board are listed on the website of the Ruralia Association.

The members of the **General Meeting** may propose **Honorary Presidents**. The general meeting votes on this. The Honorary Presidents may attend all General Meetings in an advisory capacity, but they have no voting rights.

The **budget** is denominated in Euro currency. The annual membership **fee** is 0 euros.

Members must be notified of proposed changes to the Standing Orders not less than five days before a meeting. A decision to make changes shall be made by a majority of the members present.
